Journal articles frequently have multiple authors. Author names should be listed in the order they appear at the head of the article (not in alphabetical order). In your notes, list up to three authors in full. When there are four or more authors, list only the first, followed by " et al. " (Latin for "and others").

Cite a Journal Article in Chicago Style | Format & Examples

Put author name (s) and publication year in in-text citations. The APA style uses parenthetical in-line citations. These include the author's surname and the year of publication, separated by a comma. Place the citation in parentheses before the final punctuation of the sentence containing the citation.

Your references should begin on a new page separate from the text of the essay; label this page "References" in bold, centered at the top of the page (do NOT underline or use quotation marks for the title). Citations and References Citation and reference are two different things. A citation is a note within the text in parentheses and a reference is the full expansion of that note (all the information necessary to find the referenced material). You can cite passages or quotations and provide a citation for that within the text.

To cite an online journal or newspaper article, the page numbers section from the print journal or newspaper reference is swapped with the URL or DOI the article can be accessed from and when it was accessed. So the reference for an online journal article is: Author surname (s), initial (s).

How to Cite Sources in Harvard Citation Format - Mendeley

Reference Style and Format The list of references should be alphabetically by the last name of the first author, and numbered serially. Citations in

the text should be identified by appropriate numbers in square brackets, and consecutive references should be concatenated (e.g. [7, 12-15]). The names of all authors should be listed.
