The one painting "rule" you need for oil painting is the "fat over lean" principle. Different colors of oil paint dry at different rates, from a couple of days to a couple of weeks. Those with more oil are more "fat," and those with less oil or thinned with mineral spirits or turpentine dry faster and are more "lean."

Color Mixing Guide list of oil paints. Here is your color mixing guide list of paints so far: My prepared black will have 2 parts Ivory or Mars Black, 1 part Burnt Umber, and 1/8 part Prussian Blue. You can experiment with making a very deep rich black using just Prussian blue and burnt umber. And it will dry faster than when using Ivory Black.

If glazing is your preferred oil painting technique, a tube should last a while. Harding offers a good range of colors , including traditional favorites such as lead white. The 6 Best Oil Paints

The four colors in this palette are: Yellow Ochre, Vermilion Red or Cadmium Red Deep, Ivory Black, and Flake White. These colors are the earthier versions of the three primary pigments yellow, red, and blue. With these four colors, you can get an amazing range of color. For more intense green you might want to add a Cobalt Blue to the palette.

Limited Color Palettes for Plein Air Painting

Titanium white, Yellow Ochre, Light red, English red, Raw umber, Ivory black (I usually use Winsor & Newton Artists' oil, the Light red and English red are made by Old Holland) With this palette, you can mix a base tone with the yellow ochre, white and light red. The black and the raw umber are used to cool down the 'pink' in your mixtures.
